

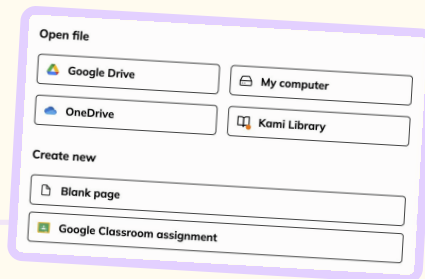
Create, annotate, and share

Step 1: Create
